

Guide to the Index

This Cumulative Index covers papers that appeared in the IEEE TRANSACTIONS ON MICROWAVE THEORY AND TECHNIQUES (T-MTT) from 1981 through 1988 and papers published in the digests of certain symposia sponsored, either cooperatively or fully, by the IEEE Microwave Theory and Techniques Society from 1984 through 1988. These symposia, together with the acronyms used to denote them in this index, are as follows:

- International Microwave Symposium (MWSYM)
- Microwave and Millimeter-Wave Monolithic Circuits Symposium (MCS)
- Cornell Conference (CORNEL).

The structure of this index resembles that of the year-end indexes that appear each December in the TRANSACTIONS. There are two parts—an Author Index and a Subject Index—both of which are arranged alphabetically.

The primary entry for each item is in the *Author Index* and is listed under the name of the first author. This entry gives the names of any coauthors, the title of the paper, and the bibliographic location of the item. For a paper published in the TRANSACTIONS, the location comprises the month, year, and page numbers, along with notification of any subsequent comments on or corrections to the paper. For a paper published in a symposium digest, the bibliographic location comprises the acronym denoting the symposium, the year of the symposium, and the page numbers. Cross references are given from the name of each coauthor to the corresponding primary entry.

In the *Subject Index*, a paper may appear under a variety of headings and modifying phrases. The citations in the Subject Index comprise the name of the first author and the bibliographic location. Note that the title of the paper and the names of any coauthors are not given. For a complete citation, it is always necessary to look up the primary entry in the Author Index. Extensive subject cross referencing has been provided.
