Scope of Symposium

The program is international in scope, featuring noted researchers from the U.S., Japan, and Europe. The program will include papers from academia, government agencies, and industry, summarizing research results relevant to the generation, detection and use of terahertz spectral radiation for space astronomy, remote sensing observation of the earth's upper atmosphere and other applications.
