Visit the Microwave Theory and Techniques Society Historical Exhibit conveniently located in the midst of the commercial exhibition area in the Moscone Convention Center.

The Exhibit includes the following sections:

1. The MTT-S library, with books that trace the early exposition of microwave theory and important experimental results.
2. A portion of the permanent Historical Electronics Museum in Baltimore, Maryland, including the following items:

Hardware, photographs and other artifacts covering the development of microwave devices dating back to the early 1930s, including early vacuum tubes as well as klystrons, magnetrons, and traveling wave tubes, and recent solid state MMIC chips and T/R modules.

Newer additions to the permanent MTT historical exhibit, including the MERA solid-state phased array and the EAR antennas developed for the Air Force.

3. Special exhibits depicting developments by local area companies and organizations in the microwave industry, including such pioneers as Varian and Hewlett-Packard.
4. Scheduled viewing of video tapes depicting historic developments and events in the microwave field.
