October Issue

Starting with the October issue, all manuscripts will be sent to the printer on or before the first of the month two months prior to the publication date. This means that all completed manuscripts, with illustrations, biographies, and photographs for the October issue must be sent to the editor by August 15th.

When submitting papers for possible publication it is necessary to send three complete copies plus all illustrations drawn in india ink on drawing paper or drafting cloth. In the past some authors have sent only two copies, others have supplied only one set of illustrations. This can only delay the process of review and publication.

We are pleased to state that with the changeover to letterpress from offset printing there has been a noticeable increase in the submission of high quality papers. We hope the trend will continue.
