XVI International Symposium on Medicinal Chemistry
Bologna, Italy
September 18–22, 2000

INVITATION

The Organising Committee cordially invites you to participate in the XVIth International Symposium on Medicinal Chemistry. The conference will review where Medicinal Chemistry is, at the end of the second millennium, and where it will be in the XXIst Century.

The city of Bologna, located in the northern part of Italy, is a short distance from Venice, Florence, Milan, and Ravenna. Bologna was selected for the venue because it is the seat of the oldest University in the Western World, and also because it will be one of the European Cities of Culture for the year 2000. Bologna is easy to reach by air, by train and by car.

The programme of the meeting includes four plenary lectures, seventy main lectures on fifteen selected topics, short oral presentations, and poster exhibitions.

The International Symposium, to be held under the joint sponsorship of the Medicinal Chemistry Division of the American Chemical Society (MC-ACS), the Asian Federation for Medicinal Chemistry (AFMC), and the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry (IUPAC), is being organised on behalf of the European Federation for Medicinal Chemistry (EFMC) by the Medicinal Chemistry Division of the Italian Chemical Society.

Application for attendance to any part of the Symposium is restricted to those who have applied in advance. The closing date for applications is August 31, 2000. All applications should be made on the Application Form (see web site) and returned with the appropriate remittance.
