8th International Symposium on Plasticity and Impact Mechanics Indian Institute of Technology Delhi, India 16 – 19 March 2003

IMPLAST'03 is the eighth Symposium in a series of meetings on Large Deformations. The aim is to provide a forum for scientists, engineers and designers in universities, scientific laboratories and industry to share their research findings in fundamental and applied aspects of the mechanics of large deformations of metallic, composite and cellular materials and structures subjected to low medium and high rates of deformation.

The Symposium will be held in New Delhi. A visit will be organised to Agra (about 200 km from Delhi), the Mogul city famous for TAJ MAHAL and Fatehpur Sikri.

The Symposium will honour Professor Norman Jones on his 65th birthday.

The programme will consist of invited and contributed papers. The proceedings will be published prior to the symposium. The following topics will be covered – the list is only indicative and not exhaustive.
