VII International Biophysics Congress and the III Pan-American Biochemistry Congress

The VII International Biophysics Congress and the III Pan-American Biochemistry Congress will be held jointly in Mexico City from August 23–29, 1981. The principal aim of this event is to bring together scientists and students engaged in the various fields of biophysics, biochemistry, and other areas of biological and physical sciences in recognition of the manifold interactions developing between these disciplines. Both the classical and newly developing areas will be represented, thereby seeking to provide the appropriate framework for participants to obtain an overall view and a more detailed insight into their fields of interest.
