## In vitro Procedures with Radioisotopes in Clinical Medicine and Research

## ORGANIZED BY:

The International Atomic Energy Agency

This symposium will be concerned with all procedures with radio-isotopes in clinical medicine and research in which the radioactive material is added to the sample *in vitro* but is not administered to the subject. (Topics to be covered include saturation analysis, dilution analysis, derivative analysis, radioimmunoassay, studies of enzyme activity, immunological studies and cytological studies on isolated tissues). The symposium will deal both with the procedures themselves and with their applications, and will give emphasis to procedures which have direct applications in clinical medicine and research. Neutron activation analysis will be excluded from the programme.

Further information and forms to accompany abstracts of papers intended for presentation at the Symposium may be obtained from national authorities for atomic energy matters. Abstracts must be submitted through these authorities so as to reach the International Atomic Energy Agency before 1 May, 1969.
