Robert Pailthorp, director of industrial processing, CH<sub>2</sub>M Hill, Inc., Corvallis, OR, was guest speaker at the March 19th meeting of the Section in San Francisco. The meeting was held at The Veneto Restaurant and was attended by over 60 members and friends. Special guests of the Section, from Lausanne, Switzerland, were University of California Regents' Professor Dominique Reymond and his wife.

In his address, "Pollution Prescription," Pailthorp reviewed the history of legislation relating to pollution control and the EPA guidelines now being formulated for companies involved in oilseed crushing and edible oil processing. He discussed proposed regulations for effluent water and solid waste and emphasized the importance to each company of taking action to comply.

The second Spring meeting of the Section was held May 21st at the Windjammer Restaurant, Tiburon. Dave McClung, chairman of the National AOCS Program and Planning Committee, reported on important committee decisions made at the last meeting of the Society in New Orleans. Frank E. Sullivan, vice president, DeLaval-Sullivan Corporation, Tiburon, spoke on "Palm Oil Processing." The meeting, preceded by a tour of the corporation's facilities, was enjoyed by 70 members and guests, including several visitors from Stockholm, Sweden. Following his address, Sullivan answered questions relating to both technical and economic aspects of imported palm oil.
