

84th Annual Meeting of the Assn. of Official Analytical Chemists

The Association of Official Analytical Chemists will hold its 84th Annual Meeting October 12-15, 1970, at the Marriott Motor Hotel, Twin Bridges, Washington, D.C. The latest developments in analytical methodology for many commodities and materials important to agriculture and public health areas will be presented and discussed.

About 1,500 chemists, microbiologists, physicists and their administrators are expected to attend, representing Federal, State, Provincial and local government agencies, universities, and industries throughout North America. Over 230 papers will be given on new techniques, methods and instrumentation for analysis of drugs, feeds, fertilizers, foods, food additives, pesticides, flavors, beverages, contamination of foods, aflatoxins and related subjects.

A special feature of the meeting will be a symposium on Analytical Methods for Forensic Science Areas to be held all day Thursday, October 15. Another symposium will also be held on International Cooperation in Study and Standardization of Analytical Methods. A roundtable discussion of pesticide formulations problems will be held in conjunction with a scientific session on the subject.

L. S. Stuart of the USDA will present his AOAC Presidential address on October 12 at the opening session. Other notable speakers will be on the daily program.

A highlight of the meeting will be a banquet on Monday evening, October 12. A special event of the evening will be the presentation of the Harvey W. Wiley Award to a winner for his outstanding contributions to analytical chemistry.

Joint Conference of the College of Pharmaceutical Sciences and the Society of Cosmetic Chemists

The College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Columbia University, and the Society of Cosmetic Chemists will jointly sponsor an Educational Conference on "Experimental Design and Statistics—With Application to Cosmetic Science," to be held at the Dellwood Conference Center, November 8-13, 1970, in New York City, N.Y.

Designed for busy research and development people from the cosmetic industry, the conference will provide the participants with an intensive coverage of experimental design accompanied by sufficient statistical background to enable statistical analysis of experimental results.

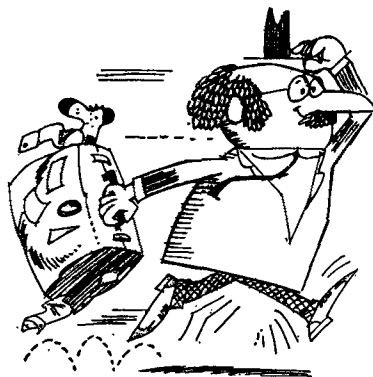
Conference participants need no prior knowledge of statistics, and although the material will go beyond the elementary level, it will be strongly application-oriented.

The conference is being chaired by W. M. Wooding, Director of Technical Services, Carter Products Research, Division of Carter-Wallace, Inc., who has gathered a staff of experts in statistics and experimental design to act as instructors for this intensive course of study.

This meeting is the Second Annual Educational Conference jointly sponsored by Columbia and the Society of Cosmetic Chemists. It represents a continuing effort to identify areas in research and development that are of interest to industrial scientists who recognize the need to strengthen their research activities.
