



# Five New Delhi plenary speakers listed

Plenary session lecturers for the International Congress on Oilseeds and Oils to be held in New Delhi during February will be Dr. F.D. Gunstone, Dr. P.A.T. Swoboda, Dr. Helmut K. Mangold, Prof. A. Rutkowski and Dr. M.S. Swaminathan.

Dr. S.C. Singhal, convener for the meeting, has extended an invitation for researchers who wish to speak during technical session at the conference to submit papers to him c/o International Congress on Oilseeds and Oils, DCM Chemical Works, PO Box 6219, New Delhi 110015, India (telex: 2488; cable: CHEMWORKS). The meeting is being organized by the Oil Technologists Association of India.

Dr. Gunstone, professor of chemistry at the University of St. Andrews in Scotland, will speak on "Natural and Synthetic Oxygenated Acids." Dr. Swoboda, principal scientific officer for the Food Research Institute in England, will speak on "Copper and the stability of Oils." Dr. Mangold, head of the Federal Center for Lipid Research in West Germany, will speak on "Chaulmoogra Oil." Specific topics have not yet been announced for Prof. Rutkowski, president of the Committee of Food Chemistry and Technology at Warsaw University, or Dr. Swaminathan, director general of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research in India.

Technical session topics will include oilseed agronomy, new sources of fats and oils; stability of fats and oils; quality control; biosynthesis, metabolism and nutriton; toxicology; process technology; and appropriate technology for developing countries.

Registration fee for non-Indians will be \$65 until Dec. 31, 1978; \$70 thereafter. Air India offices can provide information on air travel plans.
