Russian–American Seminar

Advances in the Understanding and Application of Catalysts

The Organizing Committee of the Russian–American Seminar *Advances in the Understanding and Application of Catalysts* is pleased to invite you to attend the seminar to be held in Moscow, Russia, on May 27–30, 2003. The problems to be considered are as follows:

- (1) Molecular approaches to the design of new homogeneous and heterogeneous catalysts and processes;
- (2) Synthesis, characterization, and evaluation of single-site catalysts;
- (3) Catalytic membranes;
- (4) Applications of theoretical methods for the simulation of catalyst performance;
- (5) Novel techniques for catalyst characterization at the atomic scale; and
- (6) High throughput catalyst screening.

It is planned that about 120 Russian scientists from the institutes of the Russian Academy of Sciences and Universities and 50–60 American scientists interested in the basic problems of catalysis will take part in the seminar. The working language will be English.

For the participants from Russia and CIS countries, the registration fee will be 3000 rubles (for graduate students, 1200 rubles). Hotel rooms of different categories will be reserved for the seminar participants:

Akademicheskaya hotel: \$40 (single) and \$45 (double); for the participants from the institutes of the Russian Academy of Sciences, the accommodation prices are 750 rubles (single) and 1350 (double); *Universitetskaya* hotel: 400 rubles (single) and 600 rubles (double).

The organizers would appreciate it if you could inform American colleagues and collaborators about the seminar.

We will be pleased to see you among the participants.
