

## ERRATUM

In the April 1999 issue, an error appears throughout the article “Low-Density Lipoprotein Particle Size and Coronary Artery Disease in a Childhood-Onset Type 1 Diabetes Population” by J.R. Erbey, D. Robbins, K.Y.-Z. Forrest, et al (*Metabolism* 48:531-534, 1999).

The correct unit of measure for low-density lipoprotein (LDL) particle size is the angstrom. Throughout the article, LDL particle sizes should be expressed as angstroms (Å), rather than nanomolars (nmol/L).
