This volume is the first part of the Proceedings of the 13th International Liquid Crystal Conference held at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, Canada, 22–27 July 1990. Representing the liquid crystal community, 575 delegates from 36 countries participated. This Conference marked the 25th anniversary of the first ILC Conference, which was held in Kent, Ohio, in 1965 when 42 scientific papers were presented. At the 13th ILCC, 23 invited talks were given, 140 contributed papers were presented in three parallel oral sessions and 564 contributions were presented in poster sessions.

We were fortunate to have the University of British Columbia as the site of the Conference, with its excellent facilities and its setting of natural splendor.
