The papers collected in these proceedings were presented on the occasion of the VI UPS Conference, held in Leuven, Belgium from 15 to 19 August 1993, as a successor of the conferences at Mitwitz (1982), Cleveland (1985), Shloss Elmau (1987), Almaden (1989) and Okazaki (1991).

At the conference, a group of about 200 scientists from all over the world discussed a wide variety of topics related to the spectroscopy and reactivity of excited species in the solid state. Single molecule spectroscopy and photo conduction were topics of debate, as was the use of such emerging techniques as scanning probe microscopies.
