#### **PREFACE**

The 10th International Topical Meeting on Optics of Liquid Crystals (OLC'03) was held in Aussois, France from 13 to 19 September 2003. Before the conference started, a tutorial on photonic materials and their possible connection to liquid crystals gathered many young people and seniors researchers.
