This volume presents the Proceedings of the second Japanese-Italian workshop on Liquid Crystals held in Tsu from 5 to 8 September, 2004.

The first Italian-Japanese workshop held in 2002 at Erice was organised by Italian Liquid Crystal Society and Japanese Liquid Crystal Society with the aim of bringing members of the liquid crystal communities of Italy and Japan together for a presentation and discussion of latest results in the research efforts carried out by these two communities.

In view of success of the first workshop, the second workshop was organised in the sponsorship of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science under the auspices of the Japanese Liquid Crystal Society, the Italian Liquid Crystal Society and Mie Prefecture.
