

# Erratum: Striatal Volume Changes in the Rat Following Long-term Administration of Typical and Atypical Antipsychotic Drugs<sup>☆</sup>

In an article in the August issue [Andersson C, Hamer RM, Lawler CP, Mailman RB, Lieberman JA (2001): Striatal volume changes in the rat following long-term administration of typical and atypical antipsychotic drugs. *Neuropsychopharmacology* 27(2):143–151], the legend for Figure 3 on page 147 was mistakenly printed with an error. The legend should have read as follows:

**Figure 3.** Data illustrating the effects of the atypical antipsychotic agent olanzapine (OLZ) or vehicle (VEH) on caudate-putamen volumes in animals treated for eight months. Data are expressed as means  $\pm$  S.E.M. Caudate-putamen volumes were significantly smaller in the olanzapine-treated animals versus vehicle-control animals (\* $p < 0.02$ ; Bonferroni).
