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
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

After reconsideration of the spectral data and syntheses/characterization of model compounds, it has come to our attention that the structures of the final products **1a** and **1b** should be as shown below.

The misassignment originated in the alkylation step. This occurred on the nucleobases, not on the 3'-oxygen as originally presented, hence the structure of intermediates **6** and **7** should be revised accordingly. We thank Dr's W. Wu (LaserGen) and G. Lu (Texas A & M) for valuable discussions.
