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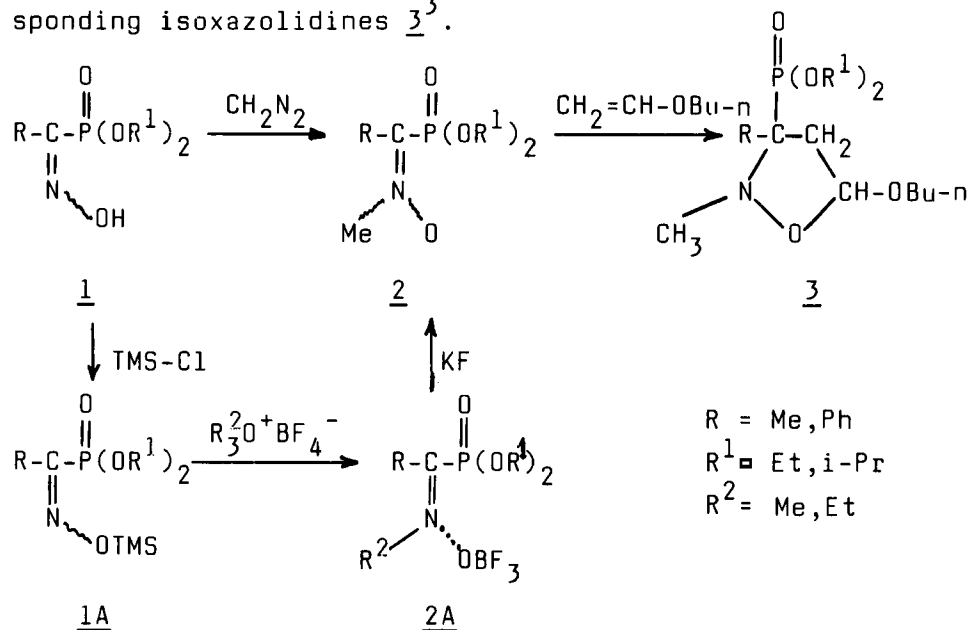
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SYNTHESIS OF ALKANOPHOSPHONATES CONTAINING NITRONE MOIETY

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α -Phosphonylonitrones are relatively new class of phospho-
 roorganic compounds ^{1,2}. Nitrones 2 are especially interes-
 ting due to the possibility of their conversion to amino-
 alkanephosphonates. In this communication we would like
 to present some results on the synthesis of α -N-alkylnitro-
 no- α -alkanophosphonates 2 and their conversion to the corre-
 sponding isoxazolidines 3.



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
