AAPS LAUNCHES AAPS OPEN

New Journal Offers More Publishing Options

In September, the American Association of Pharmaceutical Scientists (AAPS) launched its first new journal in 15 years, *AAPS Open*. The open access journal is intended to broaden the range of publishing opportunities for AAPS members and other pharmaceutical researchers.

AAPS Open is published for AAPS by Springer Science+Business Media on the same online platform as the other three AAPS journals: *The AAPS Journal*, *AAPS PharmSciTech*, and *Pharmaceutical Research*. The new journal expects to publish its first full articles in October.

AAPS Open uses the gold open access model for publication, wherein all articles are immediately freely accessible online without a subscription. The model allows authors to retain copyright in their work, while licensing Springer to publish the work through a Creative Commons license.

Also, authors from institutions that participate in the SpringerOpen Membership Program also pay discounted APCs. Details may be found at www.springeropen.com/libraries/membership.

"AAPS Open represents a significant step towards achieving AAPS' recently approved strategic vision," stated AAPS President Alice Till, Ph.D. "One of our goals is to strengthen learning, education, and knowledge resources, and AAPS Open will serve as a key new resource to meet these goals."
