#### XVI Mendeleev Congress on General and Applied Chemistry dedicated to the 250th anniversary of the Russian Chemical Science

According to the Government's order, the XVIth Mendeleev Congress on General and Applied Chemistry timed to the 250th anniversary of the foundation of the first chemical laboratory by M. V. Lomonosov will be held on May 25–29, 1998, in St. Petersburg (Russia).\*
