This is indeed, as the subtitle states, a Practical Handbook, on separation procedures of inorganic elements, mainly for analytical purposes, but also in many cases "suitable for production operations, where a slight decrease in separation efficiency may often be tolerated if substantial savings in time, labor or equipment can thereby be attained". This handbook is highly recommended to all inorganic and analytical chemists and others involved in inorganic separation methods, as the most up-to-date, practical, lucid and complete vademecum on inorganic separation methodology available in one volume.
