### PROTECTIVE MEASURES

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- 1. BUILD BARRICADE FAR ENOUGH AWAY FROM UXO SO IT CAN NOT FALL ON IT.
- 2. ALWAYS INTERLOCK SANDBAGS.
- 3. BUILD TALL ENOUGH TO DEFLECT FRAGMENTATION AND BLAST EFFECTS
- 4. UTILIZE THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF PERSONNEL.
- 5. UTILIZE ALL PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT.

WALL....LARGE MISSILE AND BOMBS



- LINE 8. PROTECTIVE MEASURES TAKEN
