

IMPROVEMENT IN CHAIRS AND CRADLES COMBINED.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

I, EDMUND STONEY, of the village of Walkerton, county of Bruce and Province of Ontario, Canada, have invented and produced a new and original article called the Child's Combination Cradle-Chair, of which the following is a specification.

The nature of my invention is fully represented in

the accompanying drawing.

Figure 1 represents the bottom of a child's combination cradle-chair, showing the hinged rockers B B for a cradle, and the casters C C attached to the rockers B B for a chair.

A A, the buttons which fasten the rockers B B up, as shown in fig. 1, when used for a chair. It also holds the rockers B B when drawn in position for use as a cradle.

Figure 2 represents the child's cradle.

H, the adjustable bow, intended to throw a vail

over when the child is sleeping.

Figure 3, the chair, the spiral spring D D, attached to the back G in an upright position, allowing the child a natural motion backward and forward, when, by

adjustable straps E E, as shown in fig. 4, attached to slides F F by means of a ring for the purpose of allowing the straps E E to move up and down with the motion of the child; also showing a back view of the chair, with cord I I to fasten at any desired height.

Figure 4 represents front view of chair, showing adjustable straps E E and slides F F and movable

slat-cushion L.

What I claim as my invention is—

The arrangement and combination of a chair and cradle, comprised of hinged rockers B B and casters C C attached to the rockers B B, buttons A A, spiral spring D D, back G, slides F F, and straps E E, and adjustable bow H, cord I I, and movable cushion L, as described.
