## IMPROVEMENT IN SMOKING-TOBACCO.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. **114,352**, dated May 2, 1871.

I, ALBERT S. ROSENBAUM, of New York, county of New York, and State of New York, citizen of the United States, have invented a certain Process to Improve Smoking-Tobacco, of which the following is a specification:

Take four pounds of juniper-berries, have them ground, leave them for a period of six months for the purpose of undergoing a fermentation; then mix them in one hundred pounds of smoking-tobacco, and the article, when being smoked, will have an agreeable aroma, making it more palatable, the smoke neutral-

izing obnoxious gases, and therefore styled "anti-asthmatic smoking-tobacco."

### *Claim.*

I claim as my invention—

The process of applying juniper-berries to smoking-tobacco so as to give it an aroma and purify the air where it is smoked.
