IMPROVEMENT IN COMPOUNDS FOR EXTERMINATING VERMIN.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 115,512, dated May 30, 1871.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, AHIRA E. PEARL, of Mansfield, county of Tolland and State of Connecticut, have invented certain new and useful Improvement or Discovery in Compound for Exterminating Vermin; and to enable others skilled in the art to compound the same I will proceed to describe.

The nature of this invention consists in pulverizing and compounding the following ingredients together in about the following proportions:

Take twenty pounds of Persian powder true; four pounds of Jamaica ginger; one pound of

camphor-gum. Thoroughly pulverize all these ingredients and compound them together, when it will be complete and ready for use; and in use has proved to be a perfect and reliable vermin-exterminator.

What I claim, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

A vermin exterminator, the ingredients combined and compounded substantially as set forth.
