

IMPROVEMENT IN COMBINED BOOT AND LEGGING.

Specification forming part of Letters Patent No. 218,995, dated August 26, 1879; application filed December 31, 1878.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, PATRICK MCNULTY, of San Francisco, in the State of California, have invented a new and Improved Combined Boot and Legging; and I hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, making part of this specification, in which the figures show a boot constructed with my improvements.

The object of my invention is to provide a combined boot and legging adapted to fit over the pantaloons and fit the ankle and leg symmetrically; and it consists in a boot having one side of the leg narrow and the other side projected toward the front to a sufficient width to wrap over the front of the leg onto the other side of the boot-leg, the sides being provided with fastening devices, and connected at the front with gore of thinner material, and lapping over when the leg-flap is secured.

In the said drawings, A is the foot of the boot, and B is one side of the leg of the boot stitched to the foot, and the other side of the

leg of the boot, S, at the middle of the heel. The side S projects forward into a flap, C, which is provided with straps D', the side B having buckles or other fastenings devices, D, to receive straps. A thin, pliable gore, E, connects the sides in front on a line with a b, so that when straps D' are brought over to fasten to D the gore folds snugly to the leg.

Having thus described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

As an improved article of manufacture, a combined boot and legging having the leg portion made of side B, provided with fastening devices D, side S, prolonged into a flap, C, integral with it and having straps D', and the interposed gore E, of light material, as set forth.
