

KARL MORSTADT, OF PRAGUE, AUSTRIA-HUNGARY.

WAFER-CAPSULE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Letters Patent No. 648,594, dated May 1, 1900.

Application filed December 16, 1899. Serial No. 740,562. (No model.)

To all whom it may concern:

Beit known that I, KARL MORSTADT, manufacturer, a citizen of the Empire of Austria-Hungary, and a resident of Ferdinandsstrasse 5 No. 20, Prague, Bohemia, Austria-Hungary, have invented certain new and useful Improvements in Wafer-Capsules, of which the following is a specification.

My invention relates to improvements in 10 capsules in which the parts have abutting edges; and the invention consists in the construction hereinafter described, and particularly pointed out in the claim.

In the drawings, Figure 1 is a sectional 15 view of one form of my invention. Fig. 2 is a plan view of one of the capsule-sections, and Figs. 3 and 4 are sectional views of modi-

Of course the capsules without edges may 20 be made in the most varied forms of section, only the ordinary forms being shown in the

accompanying drawings.

As may be seen in Fig. 1, the widened connecting-surfaces d of the two halves e of the 25 capsule are left straight, (even;) but it is no drawback if the former be provided with wall-shaped excrescences either in the form of a suitable partial upward bend b, Fig. 4,

or of a step-shaped projection c, Fig. 3, as described in my Patent No. 582,021.

In any case whether the one or the other form of construction be adopted a capsule is obtained without an edge, which removes the drawbacks arising to a greater or lesser extent in the ordinary capsules with edges and 35 fully corresponds to all the requirements requisite in medical capsules.

Having now particularly described and ascertained the nature of my said invention and in what manner the same is to be performed, 40

I declare that what I claim is-

A wafer-capsule consisting of two cupshaped parts of the same diameter to make their edges abut, the abutting portions of the capsule being widened with respect to the 45 thickness of the material and said capsule having its exterior surface smooth and unbroken throughout, substantially as described.
