General Fortier presented the problem:

What disposition is to be made of the functions of
Strategic Services Unit.

An ad hoc committee composed of 5 members to go into SSU and
get an overall picture of the entire set-up; to find out what
"boxes" there are, how many personnel are employed in each "box",
what the functions of the various "boxes" are.

General Fortier suggested that ~~any~~ each member of the ad hoc committee
visit a "box" and discover everything necessary to know in regard
to whether it should be continued or liquidated and what equipment,
if any, could be used. If a member found that another agency is
using material produced by SSU that member should visit the agency
concerned and learn the value of that material to that agency.

It was decided to meet with General Magruder of SSU on 20 February
at 9:00 A.M. and to begin the survey.
