FL-07 PATH TO VICTORY SUMMARY

LAST UPDATE: 3/2/2016

PATH TO VICTORY IN 2016:

DEMOCRATS START THIS RACE BEHIND BY 9,583 (49.2% TWO-WAY SUPPORT) VOTES. VICTORY DEPENDS ON THE FOLLOWING:

- REACH 48.5% OF THE VOTE IN SEMINOLE COUNTY, WITH A FLOOR OF 47% OF THE VOTE
- RECEIVE AT LEAST 56% SUPPORT AMONG WOMEN VOTERS
- RECEIVE AT LEAST 70% SUPPORT AMONG HISPANICS/LATINOS AND INCREASE TURNOUT TO 64.3%
- INCREASE TURNOUT AMONG 18-29 YEAR OLDS TO 58.5% AND INCREASE TURNOUT AMONG 30-44 YEAR OLDS TO 69.7%.
- RECEIVE 54% OF THE SUPPORT OF EARLY VOTERS

ABOUT THE DISTRICT:

- FL-07 is a primarily urban and suburban district, consisting of the northeast part of Orlando and Orlando suburbs to the east of U.S. Highway 4 north to Lake Monroe. The Seminole Ranch Conservation Area and Lake Harney bind its eastern border. The Orange County part of the district contains approximately 41.3% of the district's voters and Seminole County contains the other 58.7%. Key population centers in Orange County are Orlando (31.5% of total registered voters), and Winter Park (10.5% of total registered voters). Seminole County has numerous small cities making up approximately 5-10% of the district registered voters; the two largest are Sanford (10.0% of total registered voters) and Oviedo (9.1% of total registered voters).
- The district is covered entirely by the Orlando-Daytona Beach-Melbourne media market, which has an average cost per point of \$495 for political candidates and \$594 for issue campaigns.
- The district is primarily White (69.1%), but does have significant pockets of minority voters. The African American population is primarily concentrated in Sanford and makes up 9.4% of the total Citizen Voting Age Population (CVAP). Hispanic/Latino residents make up 18.2% of the CVAP; with the densest concentration is in the southeastern part of the district in Orlando. Puerto Ricans are the most predominant Hispanic/Latino ethnic group in the area, but Cubans and Mexicans also make up a large share of the Hispanic/Latino population.
- The district is wealthier than Florida on average; 28% of households make over \$100,000 a year, and another 32% make between \$50,000 and \$100,000 a year.
- Voters between the ages of 18 and 35 make up 28.0% of the district's voting age population making this district one of the youngest in the state. The presence of the University of Central Florida within the Orange County section of this district certainly adds to this dynamic with a stated enrollment of over 60,000 students.
- Florida is a party registration state. Currently, Democrats hold a very slight 0.3 point registration advantage over Republicans (35.3% to 35.0%). Independents make up 29.8% of registrants. Throughout this document, references to partisanship either reflect party registration or modeled partisanship, per Catalyst's National Partisanship Model, as noted.

REDISTRICTING:

- A court ruled in late 2015 that Florida's existing congressional map violated state law, and it was redrawn. The un-gerrymandering and elimination of minority packed districts has changed the makeup of FL-07 significantly since 26% of the voters in the new district were formally in another congressional district. The change makes the district very competitive for Democrats. The new version of FL-07 has a DPI 5.2 points greater than the 2012 version, increasing from 45.6% to 50.8%. It gains African American voters with the addition of Sanford, bringing their share of the CVAP to 9.4% (up from 7.9%). While it loses the heavily Hispanic/Latino city of Deltona, this loss is more than made up for with the addition of the new northeast Orlando section. The Hispanic/Latino CVAP now stands at 18.2%, up from 16.3%. The current district is made up

PATH TO VICTORY IN 2016:

THE DEMOCRATIC CANDIDATE WILL FIRST NEED TO WIN A FOUR-WAY PRIMARY FOR THE NOMINATION. PRIMARY VICTORY DEPENDS ON THE FOLLOWING:

- CONSOLIDATE THE SUPPORT OF AFRICAN AMERICAN PRIMARY VOTERS IN THE ORLANDO AREA
- LEVERAGE EARLY VOTE TO INCREASE TURNOUT IN FAVORABLE DEMOGRAPHIC GROUPS AND GEOGRAPHIC AREAS
- RECEIVE AT LEAST THE PLURALITY OF THE SUPPORT FROM WHITE AND HISPANIC/LATINO WOMEN PRIMARY VOTERS

IN THE GENERAL ELECTION, DEMOCRATS ARE PROJECTED TO START THIS RACE AHEAD BY 11,252 VOTES (55.6% TWO-WAY SUPPORT). ODVIOUSLY CONDITIONS MAY CHANGE FOLLOWING THE PRIMARY. GENERAL ELECTION VICTORY DEPENDS ON THE FOLLOWING:

- AT LEAST 56.5% SUPPORT FROM WOMEN VOTERS
- RAISE HISPANIC TURNOUT TO 60% AND RAISE AFRICAN AMERICAN TURNOUT TO 73%
- MAINTAIN DEMOCRATIC SUPPORT AT 87.5%
- RECEIVE AT LEAST 47% SUPPORT FROM INDEPENDENT VOTERS

ABOUT THE DISTRICT:

- FL-10 is a primarily urban and suburban district containing western Orlando and its southern and western suburbs. The district is located entirely within Orange County; approximately 67.5% of the district's registered voters live in Orlando. Other cities with more than 5% of the district's registered voters include Apopka (11.1%), Winter Garden (7.1%), Ocoee (5.5%), and Windermere (5.2%).
- The district is covered entirely by the Orlando-Daytona Beach-Melbourne media market, which has a cost per point of \$495 for political candidates and \$594 for issue campaigns.
- This is a very demographically diverse district. African American voters are primarily concentrated in western Orlando and make up 25.1% of the citizen voting age population. Hispanics/Latino residents make up 20.0% of the Citizen Voting Age Population and are distributed fairly equally across the district. The main Hispanic/Latino ethnic group in the district is Puerto Rican. The district is primarily middle and working class: 42% of residents live in households making less than \$50,000 a year and another 35% live in households with income between \$50,000 and \$100,000 a year.
- Florida has party registration and currently Democrats have an 18.5-point registration advantage over Republicans in the district (44.4% to 25.9%). Independents make up 29.7% of registered voters in the district.

REDISTRICTING:

- A court ruled in late 2015 that Florida's current congressional map violated state law and it was redrawn. The un-gerrymandering and elimination of minority-packed districts has had a huge impact on the makeup of FL-10, as it and the old neighboring FL-05 were two of the worst offenders in the state. The new version of FL-10 has a DPI 16.1 points higher than the 2012 version. The district's African American population has more than doubled from 10.5% to 25.1% of the Census Citizen Voting Age Population (CVAP), with additions in the Orlando area. The Hispanic/Latino population also rose from 16.3% of CVAP to 20.0%
- The new 2015 FL-10 is made up of several 2012 congressional districts. The parts added from old congressional districts, and the DPI of those parts, making up the new FL-10 are as follows: FL-10 (43% of new FL-10, 48.8 DPI), FL-05 (37.7% of new FL-10, DPI -75.7%), FL-09 (13.2% of the new FL-10, DPI - 67.4%), and FL-07 (6.2% of the new FL-10, DPI - 48.0%). The parts of the old FL-10 that no longer are part of current FL-10 district were mostly unfavorable to Democrats: 8% of the old FL-10

DISTRICT SUMMARY

THE CANDIDATES

John Mica (R)

Congressman John L. Mica was first elected to the House of Representatives in 1992 to represent Florida's 7th Congressional District which includes Orange, Seminole and Volusia Counties. He currently serves as the Chairman of the Subcommittee on Government Operations in the Oversight and Government Reform Committee.

Last term, Mica served as the Chairman of the House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee. He remains as a senior member of that panel and will continue to provide leadership in setting sound national infrastructure policy. In that role as the leader of one of the largest committees in Congress with broad legislative jurisdiction, Mica was responsible for developing and overseeing federal policy and projects relating to aviation, highways, transit, rail transportation, pipelines, the Coast Guard, maritime transportation, water infrastructure and resources, economic development, public buildings and emergency management issues.

Susannah Randolph (D)

As of 4/8 Susannah is a candidate in FL-09 but the DCCC has had ongoing conversations with her about moving to FL-07 where she was raised. Backgrounder is available in the candidate information folder in the FL-09 District by District folder.

Susannah Randolph, née Lindberg, started working as a political activist in college and has been doing so ever since. After holding a series of positions with consumer protection and environmental advocacy organizations, she took a job with the controversial political organizing group ACORN. Randolph served as both a Florida political director and legislative director for ACORN. Randolph and her husband, Scott Randolph, were the subject of controversy in 2009, when it was revealed that her husband – then a state representative – had sought funds for an ACORN affiliate at the same time Susannah was registered to lobby on the group's behalf. Randolph later went on to serve as an aide to U.S Rep. Alan Grayson. She worked in his district office and managed his unsuccessful 2010 campaign. While serving as campaign manager, Randolph defended a Grayson campaign ad that compared his opponent, Daniel Webster, to the Taliban and used out of context video footage to accuse Webster of commanding wives to submit to their husbands. After Grayson lost his reelection bid, Randolph went to work as executive director of the liberal advocacy group Florida Watch Now. Randolph was heavily involved in the group's "Pink Slip Rick" campaign, which sought to highlight the Governor's deleterious effect on Florida public sector jobs. Randolph returned to Grayson's office after he was elected to represent Florida's 9th District in 2012. She was still on Grayson's official payroll as of January 2014.

Bob Poe (D)

As of 4/8 Bob is a candidate in FL-10 but the DCCC has had ongoing conversations with him about moving to FL-07. Backgrounder is available in the candidate information folder in the FL-10 District by District folder.

Robert Joseph Poe is a potential Democratic candidate for Florida's Tenth Congressional District, a seat currently held by Rep. Daniel Webster. Poe is currently helping Hillary Clinton's presidential campaign in a volunteer fundraiser capacity after serving as the campaign chairman for Charlie Crist's 2014 gubernatorial bid.

An Orlando native, Poe spent more than 20 years in the broadcast industry, most notably working as station manager of WKIS and VMMO. Poe was also was part of the management team that helped market and secure television contracts for the Orlando Magic, central Florida's professional basketball team. Active in Democratic politics since he was a boy, Poe unsuccessfully ran for state senate in 1980 while remaining involved behind the scenes. In March 2000, he was elected Chairman of the Florida Democratic Party, a post he held until he was pressured to resign in the aftermath of 2002's disastrous election results. Following his resignation, Poe joined the Emergency Communications Network as President, where he stayed until 2011.
