

Introduction

Headgear of the Third Reich period has been studied and collected virtually from the time of its introduction. The shear number of variations coupled with the quality and beauty of tailoring, has created a large interest in this subject. Throughout history, the Germans have been known for their strikingly beautiful military uniforms. In the Wehrmacht of World War II, each branch of service wore a unique, identifying color of trim, or piping (waffenfarbe), on the cap and uniform coat. As a result, a beautiful collection can be assembled of caps from just the Army or Luftwaffe alone! Not only did the German military forces have tremendous variations of uniforms, many professionals such as the police, railway workers, postal workers, diplomats, political leaders, forestry officials, firefighters, etc., also wore military style uniforms!

In these two volumes, we have tried to assemble as many authentic examples of Third Reich headgear as possible, without being redundant. It is intended to serve as a photographic reference for collectors and historians, and is in no way intended to glorify this dark period in German history. The regulations and history of this headgear has been written numerous times in many fine books. We hope this work will add to that collective knowledge.









Army Propaganda Troops (Propagandatruppen) Officer's Visor Cap

Army propaganda troops officer's visor cap piped in light grey (hellgrau) waffenfarbe with silver metal national emblem and hand-embroidered aluminum oakleaf wreath and metal cockade. Cap is marked under the sweat shield with Beste Qualitat, Olympia Klasse.









Early Medical Officer's Visor Cap

Early medical officer's visor cap piped in cornflower blue (kornblumenblau) waffenfarbe. Cap has the first model (1934-1935) metal insignia with silver wire cord.

Army chaplains visor cap piped in violet (violett) waffenfarbe with silver metal "Gothic Cross" positioned between the national emblem and oakleaf wreath and cockade.



Army Administration Officer's visor cap piped in dark green (dunkelgrun) waffenfarbe with metal national emblem and hand-embroidered aluminum oakleaf wreath and metal cockade. Cap top is made of a rarely encountered serge fabric. Cap was manufactured by the firm Pekuro and is named to a Dr. Rohrhirsch.









Army Administration (Wehrmachtbeamte) Officer's Visor Cap

Administration Officer's visor with dark green (dunkelgrun) waffenfarbe. Although there is no maker's label in this hat, it has characteristics typical of the firm Paul Kaps. Note the distinctive bullion national emblem and wreath, with metal cockade. Compare this cap with the General's cap shown on page 18.







Unusual Luftwaffe officer's visor cap, not typical of a German hat maker's materials, or hat making techniques. This piece was likely made in France, or another occupied country.










Luftwaffe Officer's Soft Visor "Crusher Style" Cap

This cap has early pattern bullion insignia. It is very unusual to find a Luftwaffe officer's cap with a true soft, bendable visor. (Edwards)










Luftwaffe General Officer's Summer Visor Cap

Cap has a white waffle patterned cotton removeable top, with hand-embroidered gilt bullion second pattern national emblem, and winged wreath with vented cockade. Cap was manufactured by EREL. (Hatter)

This cap has a removable, white cotton twill top with all bullion insignia. National emblem is removable. This cap was manufactured by EREL.

Luftwaffe Flak Artillery NCO Visor Cap

Cap is piped in bright red (hochrot) waffenfarbe with metal first pattern national emblem and winged wreath and cockade. Cap is made o officers quality gabardine wool and was manufactured by EREL.









Luftwaffe Signals NCO Visor Cap

Cap is piped in golden-brown (goldbraun) waffenfarbe with metal second pattern national emblem and winged wreath and cockade. Cap exhibits a nice Sattelform.









Luftwaffe Regiment General Göring EM Visor Cap

This cap is piped in white (weiss) waffenfarbe with metal second pattern national emblem and winged wreath and cockade. (Hayes)

Luftwaffe NCO Visor Cap with Black Waffenfarbe

The black (schwarz) waffenfarbe was worn by officers, NCOs and enlisted men in the RLM (Reichsluftministerium) until June 30, 1939. By an order dated December 22, 1939, Luftwaffe Construction Engineers, as of that date, were to wear the black waffenfarbe.

Cap is piped in pink (rosa) waffenfarbe with metal second pattern national emblem and winged wreath and cockade.









Luftwaffe Administration Personnel (Wehrmachtbeamten der Luftwaffe) NCO Visor Cap

Cap is piped in dark green (dunkelgrun) waffenfarbe with second pattern national emblem and winged wreath and cockade. Cap is made of a high quality gray-blue doeskin material, and displays a nice Sattelform.









Luftwaffe Administration Personnel (Wehrmachtbeamten der Luftwaffe) NCO Visor Cap

Cap is piped in dark green (dunkelgrun) waffenfarbe with second pattern national emblem and winged wreath and cockade.









Luftwaffe Air Traffic Control Personnel NCO Visor Cap

Cap is piped in light green (hellgrun) waffenfarbe with metal second pattern national emblem and winged wreath and cockade.









Luftwaffe Fire Brigade NCO/EM Visor Cap






